By using an old technique to develop his analog photographs, Andrew Moxom looks at the modern world through 19th century eyes. Describe a scene or event from two different points of view. First describe it using your modern viewpoint and then imagine you are someone from a different time period, either past or future, and describe the scene from *that* viewpoint.



Activity

Old fashioned cameras like Andrew's display an inverted image, as seen above. By making your own "pinhole camera," you can make your own camera that inverts the image.
