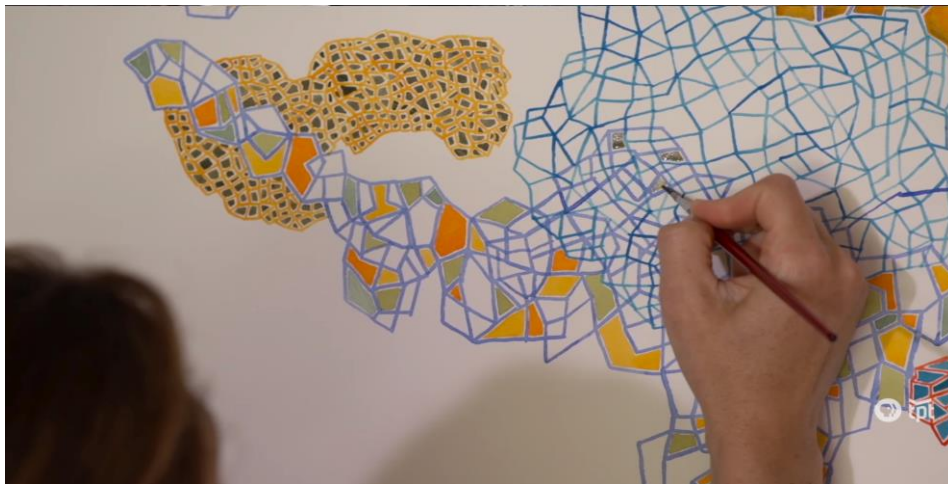


ACTIVITY GUIDE
